World Day of Prayer – Aix and Marseille

On 23rd February our Reader, Christine Portman, took part in an ecumenical service of prayer at the Eglise Protestante Unie in Aix to mark the World Day of Prayer. Each year, materials for this service are prepared by Christian women from a different country, drawing on their experience of faith in their local context. Poignantly, this year's prayers and music had been prepared by a group of Palestinian Christians (in a process beginning back in 2017, long before recent events). The result was an evening of profound intensity. Much thoughtful conversation followed the service over a delicious shared supper: Palestinian dishes created from recipes kindly provided by the organisers.

On 1st March our Curate, The Revd Roxana Teleman, took part in a similar service at the Eglise des Accoules in Marseille, another powerful act of worship testifying to the longing for peace in our world.

Chaplaincy Council

The Chaplaincy Council met on 13th January to discuss a number of items, including the Treasurer's report which provided an initial indication of our financial position at the end of 2023. The Churchwardens' report noted with gratitude a very successful Christmas Fair in 2023, which had raised €1,500 for the chaplaincy.

The Chaplain introduced a discussion on the Church of England's recent introduction of 'Prayers of Love and Faith', a set of liturgical resources designed to give thanks for the gift of a loving relationship between couples of the same sex, marking their commitment and praying with and for them. In December the House of Bishops had commended the 'Prayers of Love and Faith' for use at regular church services. (As yet there is no authorisation for standalone services.)

The date for our Annual General Meeting was set for Sunday, 19th May at 11.45 am, to be held after the morning service in Marseille and shared on Zoom. If you would like to explore becoming a member of our Chaplaincy Council, please let the Chaplain or one of the Churchwardens know.
